NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Pima County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on **TUESDAY, November 13, 2007**

in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, Administration Building, 130 West Congress Street, Tucson, Arizona, AT OR AFTER 9:00 A.M. to consider for approval the Environmental Assessment and Mitigation Report (EAMR) for Bond Project (DOT - 50) Kinney Road Improvement Project. The project involves the widening of Kinney Road, from just south of Ajo Way to just north of Sarasota Blvd., to two travel lanes and a multi-use lane in each direction; raised medians, with landscaping and left-turn lanes; reconstruction of the Ajo Way/Kinney Road intersection with additional circulation; the realignment of Bopp Road to Sarasota Blvd.; drainage improvements, and a sidewalk/paved pathway along sections of Kinney Road.
